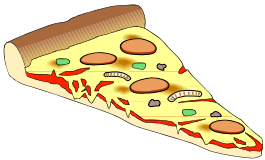

PIZZA OVENS

Ron Linnabary has been working with two different companies to see about installing the ovens that were donated to the church. We have encountered an interesting twist of events.

Cost of refurbishing and installation of donated ovens - \$1500.00

Sale of donated ovens - \$1200.00

Using \$1500 and adding the sale of the ovens we could have \$2700 to buy ovens. We are currently looking into what we can buy for roughly that amount of money from two different Columbus area restaurant suppliers. I hope we have more to discuss on this matter at our June business meeting on the 12th. I have also spoke with Bob Fracasso (the original owner of the ovens) and he thinks they are worth more than \$600 each. We shall continue this investigation in order to make the best decision possible for the council and the parish. What else is there to say, but..... To be continued.....
